This project was born as an opportunity to empower our citizens over 60 years old by training them to acquire the skills to be creative on the web and to interact with their peers.

But we do believe that the best ones to do so are the younger generations, which already use online creativity as a way of communicating.





Digital Generations project will generate the tools needed for young people to train the elderly on how to express themselves creatively, and interact with each other, avoiding social isolation.

STATE OF THE ART RESEARCH

1st Project result

The partners are actually working in the first project result of the project which will consist in an analysis of the impact of the isolation of seniors, an analysis of the communication and creative needs of this population (from the perspective of those working with them) and a collection of good practices from the countries of the consortium.

To this aim the partners have conducted 2 questionnaires one for seniors and another one for staff working with the target group in Slovenia, Greece, France, Spain and Bulgaria.



A new Transnational Project Meeting was held online in June, where the partners discussed about this result and the next steps of the project.

What is next?

During the following steps of the project, we are aiming to create a Digital Tools Handbook, develop Training & Mentoring methodologies, and share guidelines for municipalities and stakeholders across Europe.
